Under its strategic guideline “**Functional Biodiversity in Viticulture**”, the objective of which is to promote the production sustainability of agricultural systems and to create value through ecosystem services, ADVID is organising a “**Biodiversity Week**” from 28 to 31 May.

Over recent years, ADVID has conducted various studies and measures on landscape preservation and on the development and incorporation, into the grape production system, of innovative practices, aimed at increasing the biodiversity of vineyards in the Demarcated Douro Region (DDR).

The measures currently in progress include: “*Ecological infrastructures in conservation biological control of vineyard pests*”, “*Enhancing vineyard ecosystem services in the DDR*” and “*Biodivine – Demonstrating functional biodiversity in wine-growing landscapes*”.

Following up on this, we will be holding a Biodiversity Week, with diverse activities ranging from thematic Workshops to field trips to observe fauna (birds) and flora in the DDR.
